Upon graduation of the Basic Obedience class, you and your dog have learned the commands watch me, sit, down, recall with front sit, and improved leash walking. At this point your dog will respond to you without a lure during low-level distractions.

The 5-week Intermediate class takes the commands of watch me, sit, down, recall with front sit and leash walking to another level. It also will improve your dog's follow-through during challenging exercises that incorporate increased distance, duration and distractions. This class will also help prepare you to take the Canine Good Citizen test. The following will be covered in the Intermediate class:

- Sit
- Down
- Recall
- Stay, with increased Distance/Duration/  
Distractions
- Stand
- Heel
- Obedience Finish
- Leave It
- Hand Signals
- Target Training

**Sign up today!**

This class is for dogs 5 months and older. All dogs must be spayed or neutered. Obedience training not only increases the bond between you and your dog, it also teaches your dog good manners so you will be able to have a well-behaved dog when you are in public.

**Enrolling is easy:**

1. Fill out the registration form and the release form.
  2. Enclose a copy of current vaccinations (to include rabies and yearly booster) and sterilization.
  3. Mail the form with your check (c/o HSBC Behavior and Training Department) to the address on the back of this brochure.
- Classes run roughly every 5 weeks.
  - Person handling dog must be 16 years or older.
  - Please do not bring small children to class.
